How do I enter? Bring your scarecrow along to Eden Allotment Gardens on Saturday 7th August 2010. Entries must be received by 2pm. Judging takes place at 2.30pm. Simply complete the entry form overleaf and bring it with you on the day.

Who can enter? Anybody living in the Borough of Carrickfergus can enter. This competition is not open to Carrickfergus Borough Council employees or any person involved in the running of the competition, or their immediate family members. Entrants under the age of 16 must obtain permission from their parent/guardian before entering.

What are the rules for making my scarecrow?

- Your scarecrow must be made from scratch.
- Your scarecrow must be able to withstand all weather conditions.
- Your scarecrow should be a maximum height of 1.8m.
- Your entry must be a single scarecrow.
- Your scarecrow must include an element of plant material.
- You are encouraged to use recycled materials.
- You may use props or accessories to enhance your scarecrow.
- Have fun and give your scarecrow a personality!
- Your scarecrow must have a name and a description.
- You must live in the Borough of Carrickfergus.
